
### **WRITING TASK 1**

## **SAMPLE WRITING TASK 1**

Sample Band: 6.0

The bar chart presents THE number of accidents by different formS of transportation and how many people got injured per each 100 million PMT (passenger miles traveled) in 2002. In overall, It can be said that majority of passengers who had an accident while using from these 5 commonly used vehicles experienced physical damage.

IN THE FIRST PLACE, Commuter rail was the safest option of travelling when only 20 cases of incident occurred and 18 of them had injury per 100 PMT. In contrast, the highest data shows 250 for demand response and more than half of them got injured because of such incidents.

ANOTHER KEY POINT IS THAT Heavy rail seemed to be the second safest option that risked 50 commuters and two thirdS of them got injured in the rail accident per 100 PMT. Similarly the accident data for light rail and bus were same at 75, nevertheless the injury caused by bus accidentS is way higher than that OF the light rail accident.

About 50% of victims had physical damage as a result of the light rail accident whereas 90 percent of bus accident victims got injured physically.
